Nodyn | Note

Anne Adaliza Puddicombe (Allen Raine, 1836-1908), author, a daughter of a solicitor, was born in Newcastle Emlyn, Carmarthenshire. At the age of thirteen she moved, with her sister, to live in Cheltenham and Wandsworth with Henry Solly, a Unitarian minister. She moved back to Newcastle Emlyn in 1856. In 1872 she married Beynon Puddicombe, a London banker, and they moved to London. Following her husband's illness, they moved back to Tre-saith in 1900. She won first prize with a story in the National Eisteddfod in 1894. Her first novel, *A Welsh Singer*, was published in 1897. She published ten novels during the next twelve years, including, *Torn Sails* (1898), *By Berwyn Banks* (1899), *Garthowen* (1900), *A Welsh Witch* (1902), *On the Wings of the Wind* (1903), *Hearts of Wales* (1905) and

Queen of the Rushes. She also published a volume of short stories, *All in a Month* (1908). She died in 1908.
