

- f. 1            Marriage of Lewis Anwyl, 1627, 12 September: 1627, at Faenol, co. Flint, to Frances, fourth daughter of Sir William Jones.
  
- f. 2            Birth of Catherine, daughter of Lewis and Frances Anwyl, 15 August: 1628, in London.
  
- f. 2<sup>v</sup>            Murder, August 1628, of George Villiers, Duke of Buckingham, by John Felton. November 1628, Lewis and Frances Anwyl return from London to Parc, his father's house, where they live until May 1630.
  
- f. 3            May 1630 Lewis and Frances Anwyl move to Dolyfonddu, p. Llanwrin, co. Montgomery; three years later, death of Frances Anwyl at Llwyn, co. Merioneth, burial at Dolgellau.
  
- f. 3<sup>v</sup>            1632, marriage of Lewis Anwyl's sister Gwen to Richard Pole at Parc, birth of their son Anthony, 1633.
  
- f. 4            January 1632, Lewis Anwyl begins to build a new house at Cemais. Marriage of his brother Edward at Aberllefenni, April 1633, to Jane, daughter of Thomas Owen of Botalog, p. Towyn.
  
- f. 5            June 1634, Lewis Anwyl's daughter 'Cadi' goes to Shrewsbury to attend Mrs Bynnies school.
  
- ff. 7-10<sup>v</sup>        14 May 1633, death of Frances Anwyl at Llwyn, near Dolgellau.
  
- f. 11            Transcript of Frances Anwyl's epitaph.
  
- f. 11<sup>v</sup>            25 March 1648, William Owen marries Catherina, only daughter of Lewis Anwyl of Parc; moves to Llanddyn 25 March 1653.
  
- f. 12            Ellin Owen born at Caernarfon 23 May 1651; Jane Owen born at Llanddyn Hall 9 May 1653.
  
- f. 13            Frances Owen born at Llanddyn 27 May 1655; John Owen born at Llanddyn 5 September 1656.
  
- f. 17            6 February 1634, Lewis Anwyl's second marriage, at Faenol, co. Caernarfon, to Magdalen, only daughter of Sir Thomas Williams, bart., who died at Faenol 26 June 1636, and was buried at Bangor.
  
- f. 17<sup>v</sup>            Lewis Anwyl's father Sheriff of Caernarfonshire, 1637.
  
- f. 18            1 August 1637, Lewis and Magdalen Anwyl leave Faenol to live at Cemais, at Christmas went to Chester to Magdalen Anwyl's mother, Lady Williams.

- f. 18<sup>v</sup> Catherine Williams died at Pryscol, co. Caernarfon, 14 November 1639, and was buried at Bangor; her son, Sir William Williams was high sheriff of co. Caernarfon.
- f. 158 5 December 1634, death at Maesmachre of Lewis Anwyl's grandmother Mabli, wife of Edward Herbert of Cemais, daughter of Richard ap Hugh ap Ieuan of Dolyfoddu, esq.

- f. 159 23 February 1638, Lewis Anwyl's sister Catherine, wife of William Wynne of Glynne, died at Glynne and was buried at Llanfihangel.
